Texas Affiliation of Affordable Housing Providers Scholarship Application

Statement of Purpose:

The Scholarship Committee awards scholarships for the purpose of recognizing high school seniors and technical school or college students who actively reside in registered eligible tax credit properties and have pursued academic or technical excellence. These awards are intended to provide financial assistance to student residents attaining their educational and career goals. Scholarships are funded by TAAHP-affiliated fundraising events and its membership.

Eligibility Requirements - Applicants Must:

- Be a resident of an affordable housing complex which is registered with TAAHP and owned by a TAAHP Member. **(Confirmation of applicant's residency and the property's eligibility will be confirmed by TAAHP); and**
- Have a family income which is less than 60% of median income in the area in which they reside; **and**
- Have a high school cumulative 2.5 GPA on a 4.0 scale and attend a technical school or college/university (applicants must provide evidence of an acceptance letter); **or**
- Hold a GED and will attend a technical school or college/university (applicants must provide evidence an acceptance letter); **or**
- Be an existing student of a technical school or college/university with a 2.5 GPA on a 4.0 scale (applicants must provide evidence of current enrollment and current GPA).

Application Requirements & Checklist:

 - Student Information
 - School & Community Activities
- An official high school transcript with cumulative GPA (must be sealed and include Senior Year 1st Semester grades); **OR**
- Copy of GED Certification; **OR**
- A current official technical school or college transcript (must be sealed); **AND**
- 2 - Letters of recommendation from a Teacher, School Counselor or Administrator, Academic Advisor or Professor (the letter cannot be from a relative of the applicant)
- Essay on the given topic (**must be typed**)
- Photo (Head Shot Only)

Application Submission Instructions & Deadline:

IMPORTANT! Please make at least 1 copy of your completed application form for your records.

All eligibility and application requirements must be met in order for an application to be considered for scholarship awards. **Incomplete applications will not be considered.** All completed application packages must be postmarked by **April 30, 2019**. **No application materials will be accepted after the deadline.** **Applications must be delivered via the prepaid envelope included in the application package to the following address:**

Submit 2 signed letters of recommendation from someone familiar with your character, service, and achievements (high school teacher, counselor, administrator, principal, coach, community member, professor, academic advisor, etc.) Note: Letters of recommendation must be written and signed by the recommender and cannot be a relative of applicant.
