Texas Affiliation of Affordable Housing Providers Scholarship <u>Application</u>

Statement of Purpose:

The Texas Affiliation of Affordable Housing Providers (TAAHP) Scholarship Committee awards scholarships for the purpose of recognizing current high school seniors, vocational/trade/technical school, community college or university students, and applicants for vocational/trade/technical school, community college, or university who actively reside in eligible affordable housing properties. These awards are intended to provide financial assistance to student residents attaining their educational and career goals. Scholarships are funded by TAAHP-affiliated fundraising events and its membership.

Eligibility Requirements - Applicants Must:

- Be a resident of an affordable housing complex which is owned or operated by a TAAHP Member. (Applicant's residency and the property's eligibility will be confirmed by TAAHP)
- Have a family income which is less than 80% of median income in the area in which they reside.
- Be <u>a high school senior</u> and will attend a vocational/trade/technical school or college/university (applicants must provide evidence of an acceptance letter); <u>or</u>
- <u>Hold a GED</u> and will attend a vocational/trade/technical school or college/university (applicants must provide evidence an acceptance letter); <u>or</u>
- Be an <u>existing student</u> of a vocational/trade/technical school or college/university (applicants must provide evidence of current enrollment).

Note: all students are encouraged to apply regardless of GPA, as long as they are in good standing with their school. The committee will look at overall application when awarding scholarships!

Application Submission Instructions & Deadline:

IMPORTANT! Please make at least 1 copy of your completed application form for your records.

All eligibility and application requirements must be met in order for an application to be considered for scholarship awards. Completed applications will be accepted on a rolling basis but must be postmarked no later than <u>May 1, 2024</u>.
