We have a few requirements for your submissions:

- 1. The property must be 0-2 years old; rehabs will not be accepted in this category
- 2. If the property has been featured before, it will not be accepted (properties that have been submitted before but were not selected can be resubmitted if they still meet the criteria of 0-2 years old)
- **3.** You must provide high resolution interior and exterior professional photography (40% to 50% of the high-resolution photos should include photos of your residents). Professionally written stories with high quality photography are the key criteria to being selected for a two to three-page feature.
- 4. Submit professionally written stories. Please review previous magazines for examples.

We ask that you stick to the guidelines and template provided below in order to ensure consistency of the information received and published.

Submission Checklist

- Property name
- Property location (address, city, Texas)
- Photographs (up to eight) of the property and its residents (We must have <u>high</u> <u>resolution</u> (300dpi) jpeg, tiff, psd, or pdf files-this is a hard requirement). Photographs submitted within PowerPoint presentations, low quality photos or photos included within the body of a document will not be used).
- Photographer (name and/or website)
- Description of property (approx. 200 words)
- Type of funding (i.e. tax credits, USDA, U.S. Dept. OF HUD, etc.)
- Number of units and composition (i.e. tax credit only, mixed with market rate, etc.)
- Resident profiles (seniors, assisted living, families, single room occupancy, etc.)
- Developer(s)
- Syndicator(s)
- Lender name(s)
- Architect(s)
- List of on-site amenities (please limit to no more than ten)
- List of support services offered (please limit to no more than ten)
- Green initiative (i.e. LEED certifications, energy star appliances, etc.)
- Special design features
- Name and contact information of individual (to be placed in magazine) should additional property information be requested (only one contact will be listed)
